IS THIS WHAT YOU WANT FOR YOUR SCHOOL BOARD?

Mr. McCallie, I'm MRS. JOSEPH M. BUNNETT . . . I really haven't known what to think as I was sitting here, because listening to your resolution that you passed, I really was crushed. I feel that, much more properly, if you had really known the circumstances, you would have been passing a resolution commending the students at UCSC for resisting the derision and abuse which many of them received from visitors from outside, because of their reasonably calm approach to all the thing that were going on on the campus in these two days. I think, if you would look at the whole picture and I'm including asking Mrs. Lans to do this too, the new media, the people of Santa Cruz, public opinion has come to expect to encourage the certain attitudes on the part of our students today. And I must say that when you worry about professors marching with students, they were marching with students for very good reason. The communication between students and professors you can't count the . . . if no one talks to you or listens to you, and the best way to cope with this is to be all together. I know that on Thursday I was there. I was there both days. In the courtyard of Crown College there were many professors mixing with the students, talking with the students, there were long conversations. At the end of these two days, I was just proud of our students, that nothing violent occurred and I know that from talking to them, that many of them were abused and derided by visiors because they would not resort to violence, and I would strongly urge you, if you don't care to rescind the resolution you have just passed, that you pass another one commending our students for resisting temptation. Thank you.
